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Aurobindo gets registration for 23 products in South Africa

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Aurobindo Pharma today said it has got approvals from a South African authority to sell 23 different products used for treating various ailments, including HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis C and inflammation.

Medicines Control Council (MCC), South Africa has granted 23 registrations to manufacture and market products in South Africa, Aurobindo Pharma said in a statement.

The products include Bavir 300 mg tablets, capsules of Deladex 200 mg, Soniren 250 mg, Segiref 400 mg (used against HIV).

Moreover, the company has now been approved to sell anti -hepatitis C tablets Auro-Ribavirin and Dorik in 200 mg strength.

Besides, the company said it has got registration for an anti-inflammatory medicines Auro-Meloxicam 7.5 mg and Flamaryx 15 mg tablets.

On Monday, Aurobindo had announced that it has entered into an agreement with global bio-pharmaceutical company AstraZeneca to supply several solid dosage and sterile products to emerging markets.

The company's scrips were trading at Rs 1,032.85 per share, down 0.40 per cent from the previous close on the Bombay Stock Exchange.

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
